Over 7,000 students and educators visit the island every year to explore our rich history surrounding the War of 1812 and the early island settlers as well as the natural geological treasures of our caves. It's quite a unique learning experience!

The Tour Train is a great experience for students and adults alike. With a one hour narrated historical tour, your students will learn the history of the island as well as see the sights. While on the Tour Train, you'll have the chance to stop off at Perry's Cave, which is a registered Ohio National Landmark formed over 400 million years ago; the Butterfly House, which has 50 different species of butterflies from Costa Rica and Malaysia; put your navigation skills to the test in Fort aMAZE'n; test your climbing ability on the 25 foot tall rock climbing wall; take a swing at the War of 18 Holes putt-putt course; and walk inside the largest known geode in the world at Heineman Winery and Crystal Cave.
